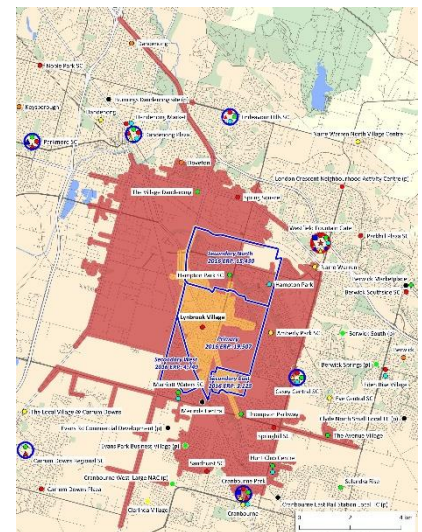
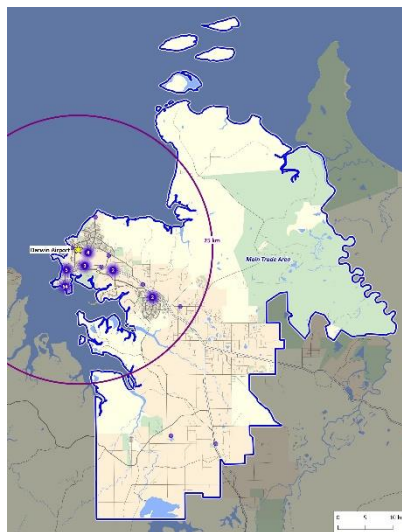

What is QGIS?

QGIS is an open source desktop Geographic Information System (GIS) software designed to capture, store, manipulate, analyse, create, manage, and display all types of geographical data.

Geographic Information Systems are used in a wide range of fields such as urban and town planning, transportation and infrastructure planning, market analysis, disaster risk reduction, public health and many others.



What are the prerequisites?

This course has been designed for users with little or no experience in QGIS that wish to become competent in the software. No previous experience with GIS software is required.

What is the content covered by Location IQ's QGIS training?
